New Delhi: Cabinet secretary Rajiv Gauba on Wednesday asked states to complete contact tracing of all Tablighi Jamaat members who attended events at the outfit's Nizamuddin headquarters on a war footing and highlighted the risk it posed to efforts for containment of Covid-19. In a meeting held via conferencing with chief secretaries and police chiefs of states, Gauba asked state police to initiate action against foreign Tablighi Jamaat preachers for having violated their "tourist" visa conditions by indulging in "missionary" work. TJ member tries to jump off hospital building

The number is likely to go further as test results of nearly 8,000 TJ followers and people who came in contact with them after the gathering at Nizamuddin mosque is still awaited. Also, government data shows, 16 people connected to the TJ meet — three foreigners and 13 Indians — have died in different states. Some have been confirmed positive for Covid-19 while the reports of others are awaited.

Mostly young national who had attended the meet died at Delhi's Rajiv Gandhi Super Speciality Hospital (RGSSH) on Wednesday. Hospital authorities claimed he had tested negative for Covid-19. Another TJ member, a 64-year-old man from Tamil Nadu, died at Lok Nayak Hospital Tuesday. He has been found positive for Covid-19, sources said.

There were chaotic scenes at RGSSH on Tuesday where more than 100 TJ members were quarantined when one of them attempted to jump off the building. Some patients also turned aggressive, doctors said. Full report on www.toi.in

'Follow lockdown in letter & spirit'

New Delhi: The Centre on Wednesday cautioned states against allowing exceptions to the lockdown other than those permitted under the consolidated guidelines issued by the home ministry under the Disaster Management Act.

STATES WARNED

No exception for sale or delivery of liquor is allowed under the ministry guidelines. In a letter to state chief secretaries, home secretary Ajay Bhalla said allowing exceptions other than those in the guidelines issued on March 24, followed by addenda on March 25 and 27, was a violation of lockdown measures and defeated the efforts to contain the spread of Covid-19.

In case of a few states, the delivery of essential items is being staggered. Instead of providing 30kgs per beneficiary to Jharkhand in one shot, FCI will provide 18kg this month and the rest in the first week of May.

Over the next couple of weeks, the focus will be back on procurement, which is expected to start in mid-April.

The absence of passenger trains is helping in faster movement of goods. Trains with goods moving from Punjab to Assam in 3-4 days against the usual 5-6 days. "How quickly we move fresh stocks also depends on the ease at which godowns empty," an FCI officer said. You can't buy justice with money, SC tells BMW owner

New Delhi: "You cannot buy justice with money," the Supreme Court said on Wednesday and dismissed Vismay Ananthbal Shah's appeal against his conviction and five-year sentence, for causing the deaths of two students while rashly driving his BMW in Ahmedabad in February 2013.

2 STUDENTS KILLED

This brazen display of money power did not go down well with the judges, who said, "You cannot buy justice with money." It went on to dismiss Shah's special leave petition challenging the Gujarat High Court's February 17 decision, which had upheld an Ahmedabad trial court's July 13, 2015, judgment. The trial court had held Shah guilty of rash and negligent driving, which caused the deaths of two students who were travelling in an autorickshaw. Both students were the only children of their parents.
