Google.org offers \$3-million to help education initiatives

Google.org, the philanthropic arm of Google, announced an additional grant of \$3 million over the next two years to Central Board of Secondary Education and The Central Square Foundation, which focuses on improving education, will be awarded a grant of \$2 million and technical assistance from the Google Learning Team to create high quality curriculum-aligned video content. The grant will support a team of 20 content creators to produce 200 hours of content, technology, engineering and math content and other vernacular languages. In addition, it will set up a hub to share best practices on how to create engaging videos.
